

NUMBERS

Issued only with a <u>signed open check</u> deposited with the horse show secretary.

Classes offered will be conducted and judged according to the appropriate sanctioning organizations

SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER/ FEDERAL ID

Owner's Social Security number or Federal ID number MUST be on the entry form of any horse and/or pony exhibited in classes where prize money is awarded.

COMPETITION OFFICE HOURS

Competition Days – one hour before start of first class – 30 minutes following completion of last class.

MEMBERSHIP NUMBERS

A signed entry blank with association membership numbers for each horse, owner, & rider must be submitted to the show office prior to end of show in order for points to count.

SERVICE FEE

All horses, showing and non-showing will be charged a \$15.00 fee. This fee allows the horse unlimited add/scratches from classes, access to schooling areas and rings at designated times, and contributes to office and medic costs.

SPLITTING OF TACK STALLS

The show office will split tack stalls and shavings counts per Trainers instructions among customers up to close of office on Friday. After that time the total tack stall amount will be billed to the trainer's barn account and office will make shavings splits.

STABLING BEDDING

A minimum of two bags is mandatory. Initial bedding will not be provided. Bedding orders are to be made through the office. Deliveries other than those made through the horse show office are prohibited. No Sunday deliveries

DAMAGE

All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents, or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds and will be billed accordingly.

REFUNDS

Refunds will not be made after the show begins, except for lameness of horse or illness of rider. Refunds due to billing errors will be made only within 24 hours after close of show. Please check your bills carefully. **LUNGING**

No lunging permitted in the show rings or schooling areas at any time. Lunging only in designated areas.

POLING & OFFSETS

Manual poling and the use of bamboo off-sets are prohibited for all horses competing. Anyone involved

with poling will be subject to a fine of \$500. **SCHOOLING**

Schooling in the show rings without permission is prohibited at all times. Ticketed warmup will be available for schooling on Friday afternoon as designated and after the show each day as designated. Closing times will be announced each day. The rings are to be available for limited schooling in the mornings. Management may restrict schooling if conditions warrant.

DAY EXHIBITOR / NON STABLING HORSES

Horses entered but not stabled must use the designated area for day exhibitors. There is a \$25 grounds fee per horse and \$15 office fee per horse per day.

NON SHOWING HORSE

All non-showing horses must have a signed entry blank in the office and pay non-showing fee.

NON NEGOTIABLE CHECKS

Checks returned by the bank for any reason will be assessed a \$35 penalty, or 10% of the check amount, whichever is greater. Upon notification of a returned check, accounts will be given three (3) days to make full payment, including penalty to be paid in certified funds, cashier's check or money order. Overnight mail is advised in order to avoid notification of the sanctioning organizations for disciplinary action.

Food service will be available on the grounds beginning the day of the show.

PARKING

Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans, and campers from being parked in the stable areas. Vehicles will be allowed in stable areas to load and unload only. Parking areas are designated and violators will be towed at owner's expense.

PROTECTIVE HEADGEAR

All exhibitors are required to wear properly fitting, ASTM protective headgear on the show grounds when mounted with harness secured snugly and properly fitted while riding in designated schooling and exercise areas, the show ring and while jumping anywhere on the show grounds. It is the responsibility of the rider, parents, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see to it that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition.

MINOR RIDERS

Parent(s) or guardian(s) of a minor child shall hold the horse show management and the facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No minor child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless a parent or LEGAL guardian signs entry.

DOGS

All dogs must be on a leash of no more than 6 feet in length, or otherwise contained, at all times while on competition grounds. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to impoundment by the horse show or by the local government. Owners of loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to penalties and/or fines under GHJA Rules 18 and 19. Warning cards may be issued to such dog owners, an accumulation of which shall result in further penalties.

CONDUCT

Any act of Discourtesy to a Judge show Official or staff member on the part of any trainer, owner, rider, or groom or parent or guardian will immediately disqualify any horse with which they are associated and all entry fees will be forfeited.

SCHOOLING FEE

Schooling Fee is applied to each entry to cover Medic and supervised show ring schooling from approximately 1-6 pm on Load-in day and pre and post show schooling, dependant on conditions. Check with show office for schedule adjustments.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES

Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind,including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds. Failure to abide by these regulations will subject the exhibitor to suspension from the horse show. USEF GR 1301.7

MEMBERSHIP

No points will be counted toward GHJA annual awards before membership dues have been paid and the horse or pony is registered with GHJA

MEASUREMENT

Ponies must possess a current GHJA or USEF measurement card, to be presented at check-in. OVER FENCES ENTRY LIMIT

Ponies/Horses may not enter more than seven over fences classes in any one show day. including equitation medals and Hunter Classics.

SHOW RING CONFLICTS

Three Minute Rule will be in effect at management's discretion. Upon notification to exhibitors the classes can be canceled if there is not a horse in the ring within three minutes of the start of the time clock. No refunds will be issued. Please be considerate to your fellow exhibitors

JUDGING

All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Management may restrict the courtesy circle by a mandatory dotted line which shall be indicated on the course diagram. If order of go is established the one minute rule will be in effect. Otherwise the three minute rule will be in effect.

ATTIRE

Proper attire is required in all classes. JUMPER CLASSES

To be eligible for prize money awards you must enter respective division during show day.

HOLDING CLASSES

Under no circumstances will a flat class or under saddle be held for a trainer conflict, unless the conflict concerns the horse being in another ring. Equitation classes and jumper classes, may at management's discretion, follow a posted order of go. Management will designate priority rings

ELECTRICAL/FIRE REGULATIONS

All electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisle shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six (6) feet wide by eight (8) feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in these aisles. No Class I Flammable liquids such as gasoline, are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within any stable area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the Horse Show without

LIABILITY

Horse Show Ventures, the facility operators, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitors, spectators, guest, groom, attendant, other employees, animals, or equipment at any of the competitions. All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third persons caused by themselves, their employees, their agents, their horses, or their dogs. They are strongly advised to take out third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events, and to keep that policy up to date

The Horse Show management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show management. Its decision shall be final.

Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but show management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire, or other cause.

Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without any claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to re-schedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

ENTRIES

All Entry Forms must be signed by an adult: competitor, parent, and/or Trainer as designated.

PRIZES & AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded first through sixth place. Championship and Reserve Champion ribbons and awards (as applicable) will be awarded for hunter and equitation divisions with at least two over fences and an undersaddle class with three competitors completing classes. Prize Monies will be deducted from show bills with check for any balance issued no later than 30 days past show date.

POINTS & YEAR-END AWARDS

To be eligible for HSV year-end awards, the rider, owner, and horse/pony must be a member of Horse Show Ventures. Point accumulation begins on the date that completed registration and payment is received.

HUNTER SPECIFICATIONS

HUNTER OVER FENCES & COURSES

To be shown over at least eight fences at the required height. To be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Hunter courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as brush, wall, in and out, oxer, post and rails, gate, aiken, bank, coop, and panels. Management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spread as competition warrants.

HUNTER UNDER SADDLE

To be shown at a walk, trot, and a canter. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required.

ADDBACK HUNTER WARMUPS

Open to all horses and ponies. Addback money paid to top six places: 30%, 25%, 20%, 10%, 10%, 5%. If there are less than six horses in class, the entry fee drops to the regular class fee with no prize money paid back, unless otherwise specified.

ATTIRE

Proper attire required in all classes.

HUNTER DIVISIONS

Southeastern Hunter Jumper Series/ Horse Show Ventures shows are Local Member Shows of the Georgia Hunter Jumper Association, Inc., and is operated in accordance with the current rules of the GHJA. Every person who participates in the show is responsible for a knowledge of and is subject to GHJA rules. The following divisions are recognized by GHJA and points won will count toward end of the year high score awards. These Divisions are GHJA

SHORT STIRRUP HUNTER

Open to riders ages 12 yrs. and under on horses or ponies, in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any hunter show. Note: Participation in once around-twice around or beginner and crossrail classes will not count as part of these two years, as long as the jump height does not exceed 18". Rider may cross enter only into Pre-Child / Pre-Adult Hunter (2'6" only) and age group equitation, not to inlcude any medal classes. Riders may enter non-recognized classes where fence heights do not exceed 2' for ponies and 2'6" for horses. Riders may not enter "under saddle" or "flat" classes that do not fall within these parameters. Riders may show in Short Stirrup classes for two consecutive years.

SCHOOLING PONY

Fences 2' or 2'6". May jump either height at rider or trainer's discretion. Open to Junior riders only. Fences will be set on 12' strides.

PONY HUNTER

Pony hunter sections will be combined if less than three entries in each. **SMALL PONY HUNTER** Fences 2' (ponies not to exceed 12.2hh).Rider 12 or younger.

MEDIUM PONY HUNTER Fences 2'3" (ponies over 12.2hh, but not to exceed 13.2hh). Rider 14 or younger.

LARGÉ PONY HUNTER Fences 2'9" (ponies over 13.2hh but not to exceed 14.2hh) Pony Hunter division will be measured on a 12' stride.

OPEN HUNTER

Fences 2'6" or 3' (horse or pony). Rider may show in either height group at rider's or trainer's discretion.

Modified Hunter

Modified Hunter: Open to all horses or ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs or professionals. Fence height 2'9.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Fences 3'. Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. A pony ridden in the Adult Amateur Hunters may not cross enter into any Pony Hunter division or Junior Equitation division or Junior Medal at the same show.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER

Fences 3'. Open to all horses ridden by a Junior.

JUNIOR/AMATEUR HUNTER 3'3"

Open to all horses ridden by a Junior or an Amateur.

WORKING HUNTER 3'6"

Open to all horses ridden by a Junior or an Amateur. Fences at 3'6"

LONG STIRRUP HUNTER

Open to Amateur and Junior riders, 13 years of age and older oponies in their first or second year of showing over fences high hunter show. Note: Participation in once around-twice around or beginner and crossrail classes will not count as part of these two years as long as the jump height does not exceed 18". Adult riders who are re-entering the show ring after an absence cannot have shown over fences higher than 2'6" in the past five years. Riders may compete in this division no more than 2 consecutive years. The two years of long stirrup eligibility are continuous show calendar years that cannot be separated or divided in any manner. A rider may cross enter only into Hunter divisions and age group equitation at the same show if fence height does not exceed 2'6", not to include any medal classes. Riders may enter non-recognized classes where fence heights do not exceed 2'6". Riders may not enter "under saddle' or "flat" classes that do not fall within these parameters. Fences 2'3".

PRE-CHILDRENS & PRE-ADULT

Pre-Children's Hunter: Open to Junior riders on horses or ponies; horse/rider combination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show in the previous 3 years. Fence height 2'6" Pre-Adult Hunter: Open to Adult Amateur riders on horse or ponies; horse/rider combination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show in the previous 3 years. Fence height 2'6".

HSV & Marshall & Sterling (M & S) HUNTER CLASSICS

To be scored under the open numerical judging system. Second Hunter trip of section will serve as first round of Classic. The highest 10 scores from Round 1 will return in order of lowest to highest score, adjusted by fence height. Trophies will be awarded. Marshall & Sterling Rated. <u>DOUBLE GHJA POINTS FOR ALL CLASSICS</u>

HSV \$500 Classic Classes

There will be three \$500 Classic Classes offered at each show:

The \$500 Horseshow.com Pony Hunter Classic

\$500 Pre-Child/Pre-Adult Hunter Classic

\$500 3' Open Hunter Classic

Open to both horses and ponies.Professionals will be limited to the 3' Open Classic. Same horse and rider combination may not compete in two different fence heights at the same show. Course to be set on the 12' stride. No in and out. Two round format with the first round to be typical hunter classic course and the second round to include "handy" type questions. Points to be tabulated by money won. All money earners will be invited to the finals in November. *Guaranteed payout with three entries*. Prize Money payout to seven places as follows 30%, 20%, \$15%, 12%, 10%, 7%, and 6%. Entry fee \$45.

All Money earners will be invited to compete in a \$1500 Classics for their divisions at the HSV Year End Finals.

HSV RATED HUNTER DIVISIONS

Adult, 11 & UNDER AND 12 & OVER WALK TROT (& CANTER)

Open to horses and ponies. Intended for the beginner rider. Will be divided into sections as necessary and all riders in each section pinned. Entries may be limited. Participation in these divisions is limited to two consecutive years.

CROSS RAILS

Open to horses and ponies. Riders, ages, as designated, who have never jumped over 2' in competition. May enter Mini Hunter division and may enter other beginner under saddle classes in the Academy ring. Limit two year participation in the cross rail divisions. Fences 12"-18".

MINI HUNTER

Open to horses and ponies. Intended for the beginner rider and/or green horse that has never jumped over 2' in competition. If rider meets crossrail specs. Horse/rider may enter crossrail division. Rider can only enter in one mini hunter division per show. HSV year end points will follow the rider only. Fences can include oxers, gates, boxes brush boxes, flower boxes. Fence height 18".

SCHOOLING HUNTER

Open to horses and ponies. Intended for beginner rider and/or green horse that has never jumped over 2' in competition. Fences can include oxers, gates, boxes, brush boxes, flower boxes. Fence height 2'.

BABY GREEN HUNTER

Open to all horses and ponies of any age that have not been shown over a course of fences 2'9" or higher, equitation classes included. Fence height is 2'-

SPECIAL HUNTER

Open to all horses and ponies of any age. Fence height is 2'3".
PRE-SHORT & LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION

Open to all advanced beginner riders on horses or ponies that have not yet moved into the short or long stirrup divisions. Section may be combined if there are more than three entries in each age category. Fences 18".

CHILDREN'S PONY EQUITATION

Open to all junior pony riders. Fences 2' or 2'6" at riders discretion.

HUNT SEAT EQUITATION

ATLANTA SADDLERY EQUITATION CHALLENGE ON THE FLAT

Open to Junior and Amateur riders on ponies or horses. Riders will be judged at a walk, trot, canter. The top six riders may be asked to perform any of the USEF tests 1-19 or combination thereof. No martingales of any kind are allowed in this class. Six riders are needed to fill this class. A cooler and six ribbons will be awarded. Outside assistance during the class will be penalized. The top 20 riders who have accumulated points throughout the year will qualify to participate in HSV Finals Equitation Challenge. Entry fee \$35.

GHJA JUNIOR'S EQUITATION CHALLENGE GHJA Junior's Equitation Challenge Open to all Junior or Amateur riders on horses or ponies. To be judged at a walk, trot, and canter. Competitors will be asked to perform at least two of the following USEF tests chosen by the Judge: #1-Halt; #2-Hand gallop; #9- Ride without stirrups; #15-Change leads on a line demonstrating a simple or flying change of lead; #17- Canter on the counter lead. Martingales are not permitted. Riders receiving outside assistance or coaching while in the arena will be eliminated. Riders who have won the Junior's Equitation Challenge Final in 2009, 2010, or 2011 are not eligible to compete in this class. November 1st is the cutoff date for qualifying for the Junior's Equitation Finals. Participation in the Junior's Equitation Finals is limited to current Junior and Adult Amateur Members of the GHJA

SHORT STIRRUP EQUITATION

Open to qualified Short Stirrup riders. 2' Fence height.

All are GHJA rated, EXCEPT Pre-Children's & Pre-Adult Equitation and Pre-Short Stirrup Equitation, Children's Pony Equitation.

HUNT SEAT EQUITATION

11 & Under Equitation Fences 2' 12-14 Equitation Fences 2'6" 15-17 Equitation Fences 3' Short Stirrup Equitation Fences 2' Long Stirrup Equitation Fences 2'3" Pre- Children's & Pre-Adult Equitation Fences 2'6" Adult Amateur Equitation Fences 3' Pre- Short & Pre-Long Stirrup Equitation Fences 18" Children's Pony Equitation Fences 2' or 2'6"

EQUITATION MEDAL CLASSES

To be shown over a modified jumper type course of at least eight fences. The courses must include at least one oxer and change of direction. Three entries must complete both phases of qualification for points to count and must be a GHJA member

JUMPER SPECIFICATIONS

JUMPER LEVELS

ADDBACK MONEY

All Jumper classes will operate as Addbacks. Prize Money is paid back to top six places: 30%, 25%, 20%, 10%, 10%, 5%. If there are less than six horses in class, the entry fee drops to \$15 with no money paid back.

ATTIRE

Riders will be allowed to show in tucked in polo shirts in the jumper classes. The Classics and Mini Prixes require formal attire.

COURSES

Courses may consist of any combination of the following brush, gates, oxers, post and rails, water, liverpool, ditch, wall banks, panels or coops.

ORDER OF GO

Will be posted one hour prior to the start of the class.

45 SECOND CLOCK

Will be in effect in all jumper classes

DECLARATIONS

Declarations must be made on the appropriate form in the show office the day before the class to be held by 4 pm or one hour after the last Jumper class

TIME ALLOWED

The time allowed is based on a minimum of 382 yards per minute for all sections.
