

Every person who participates in the show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the rules of the GHJA. Participants have access to a copy of the current rule GHJA rule book at www.ghja.org. No points will count toward year-end awards until membership dues have been paid and horse is registered with GHJA. GHJA membership is required *only* for those classes designated with * on class schedule.

Horse Show Ventures is a USHJA Affiliate Member and offers USHJA Outreach Classes as part of the show series. This offers free Outreach USHJA Memberships for Horse Show Ventures members, Affiliate Year-End High Point Awards and the opportunity for national recognition and awards by participating in USHJA Outreach Classes. Riders must declare USHJA Outreach class participation in order to accrue USHJA points. Fee: \$2 per class. See complete rules and specifications on page

HUNTER & EQUITATION SPECIFICATIONS

HSV RATED HUNTER & EQ DIVISIONS WALK HALT (& TROT 1 @ A TIME)

For early beginner riders. Coaches/handlers permitted in ring for safety, if needed; however excessive coaching may be penalized. May cross enter leadline.

WALK TROT (& CANTER 1 @ TIME)

Open to horses and ponies. Intended for the beginner rider. Will be divided into sections as necessary and all riders in each section pinned. Entries may be limited. Participation in these divisions is limited to two consecutive years.

GROUND POLE HUNTER

Open to horses and ponies. Intended for beginner riders that have **not** competed in Crossrail or higher in competition. Riders may not cross enter into crossrails or higher over fences classes. Limit 2 years participation. Poles are placed on ground. Trotting courses encouraged. CROSS RAILS EQ & CROSS RAIL HUNTER

Crossrails EQ is for inexperienced riders who have never jumped over 2' in competition. May enter Mini Hunter divisions and other beginner under saddle classes in the Academy ring. Limit two year participation in the cross rail divisions.

Cross Rail Hunter is open to beginner junior and amateur riders Fences 12"-18".

NOVICE MINI HUNTER 18"

Open to inexperienced riders on horses and ponies. Intended for the beginner rider that has never jumped over 2' in Competition. Simple changes acceptable. If rider meets crossrail specs. Horse/rider may enter crossrail division. HSV year end points will follow the rider only. One entry per rider each show day. Fences can include gates, boxes brush boxes, flower boxes. Fence height 18".

MINI HUNTER 18"

Open to all horses and ponies and riders. Mini Hunter may cross enter into Novice Mini Hunter (if eligible) and Crossrail Hunter. Simple changes acceptable. Points follow horse. Fences can include gates, boxes, brush boxes, flower boxes. Fence height 18".

SCHOOLING HUNTER 18"-2"

Open to horses and ponies. Intended for beginner rider and/or green horse that has never jumped over 2' in competition. Fences can include oxers, gates, boxes, brush boxes, flower boxes. Fence height 18"-2'. GREEN HUNTER FLAT

Division consisting of two flat classes. Open to all horses and ponies of any age and all riders. Intended for the green horse/pony.

LOW CHILD/ADULT HUNTER 2'

Open to Adult Amateur & Junior riders. Horse/Rider combination may not cross enter into classes higher than 2'3".

SPECIAL HUNTER 2-2'3"

Open to all horses and ponies and riders. Fence height is 2'-2'3". GREEN HUNTER 2'3"

Open to horses and ponies in their first or second year showing over fences higher than 2' at any show. Eligibility is limited to two consecutive show years during which time the horse or pony may not show in any division with fences higher than 2'6" or it will lose its green status. A pony ridden by an adult or professional rider may not cross enter into any Pony Hunter, Junior Equitation or Junior Medal class at same show.

SILVER STIRRUPS HUNTER

Open to adult amateur riders 35 & Over who have not shown over 2'6" at a show in past three years. Fence Height 2'. No oxers.

PRE-SHORT & LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION

Open to all advanced beginner riders on horses or ponies that have not yet moved into the short or long stirrup divisions. Fences 18".

HSV BEGINNER MEDAL 18"

Intended for the beginner rider on a horse or pony. Equitation course with gates, boxes, brush boxes and flower boxes. Fences 18". Riders can not have shown over 2' in competition.

HUNTER CLASSICS

To be scored under the open numerical judging system. Second Hunter trip of section will serve as first round of Classic. Second Classic round is an individual class. Feature Prizes and Ribbons awarded through 1-8 places. Horse must be entered in entire division to participate in the classic.

any of the USEF tests 1-23 or combination thereof. No martingales of any
kind are allowed in this class. Feature Award and ribbons to sixth place
awarded. Outside assistance during the class will be penalized. The top
20 riders who have accumulated points throughout the year will qualify to
participate in HSV Finals \$250 Championship Medal Challenge. Entry
fee \$20.

HSV Friday Night HUNTER DERBIES \$250 Low Hunter Derby 2', 2'3"

Open to junior riders on horses or ponies.

Feature first place prize, payout to sixth place, ribbons 1-8th.

Riders will compete over a hunter derby type course with 9-10 obstacles.

There will be two rounds, a Classic round and a Handy round. Class will be judged by a single judge providing a numerical score. Riders are called back in reverse order.

JUMPER SPECIFICATIONS

ADDBACK MONEY

Excluding Beginner Jumper classes, Jumper classes will operate as Addbacks. Prize Money is paid back to top six places: 30%, 25%, 20%, 10%, 10%, 5%. If there are less than six horses in class, the entry fee drops to \$15 with no money paid back.

ATTIRE

Riders will be allowed to show in tucked in polo shirts in the jumper classes. The Classics and Mini Prixes formal attire (white or tan breeches and show coat) is encouraged.

COURSES

Courses may consist of any combination of the following brush, gates, oxers, post and rails, water, liverpool, ditch, wall banks, panels or coops.

ORDER OF GO

Will be posted one hour prior to the start of the class.

DECLARATIONS

Declarations must be made on the appropriate form in the show office the day before the class to be held by 4 pm or one hour after the last Jumper class

TIME ALLOWED

The time allowed is based on a minimum of 382 yards per minute for all sections.

TIES

All ties involving first place shall be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be decided by time, unless otherwise stated.

POLING AND OFFSETS

Manual poling and use of bamboo offsets are prohibited for all horses competing. Any rider, trainer, groom, or other person who is in violation of the rules set forth above will be fined \$500 for each incident and may be suspended from further competitions for the duration of the

scheduled event.

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible, you must enter respective division.

.65m JUMPER

Open to any horse and rider. Fences 2'1" HSV rated only.

.70m JUMPER

Open to any horse and rider. Fences 2'3" HSV rated only.

.70m Young JUMPER

Open to horses 7 years or younger and any rider. Fences 2'3".

HSV

.75 m JUMPER

Open to any horse and rider. Fences 2'6" HSV rated only.

.80m JUMPER

Open to any horse and rider. Fences 2'7". HSV rated only.

.85m Low Child/Adult JUMPER*

Open to Junior and Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Horse /rider combination may not cross enter into classes higher than .90m at same horse show. Fences 2'9"

.90m JUMPER*

Open to any horse and rider. Fences 2'11".

.95m JUMPER

Open to horses and ponies. Fences 3'1".

Child/Adult .95m JUMPER*

Open to Junior & Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Horse/rider combination may not cross enter into classes higher than 1.10m (3'7") at the same horse show.

Fences 3'1".

1.00m JUMPER*

Open to Junior Riders on horses or ponies. Fences 3'3".

1.10m JUMPER*

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences under 3'6".

1.15m JUMPER

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences 3'9".

1.20m JUMPER

Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences 3'11"

The * Divisions are GHJA rated.

GHJA Class Specifications

<u>Hunter Over Fences</u> To be shown over at least eight fences at the required height. To be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise stated.

<u>Hunter Under Saddle</u> To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Light contact with the horse's mouth is required. Martingales not permitted.

<u>Courses</u> Hunter courses will simulate fences found in the hunt field such as brush, wall, in-and-out, oxer, post and rails, gate, aiken, bank, coop and panels.

All hunter divisions will be held in accordance with GHJA rules. Hunter Divisions with less than 3 entries may be combined. Pony must possess and present to the office a GHJA or USEF measurement card to compete in any Pony Hunter division. Thoroughbred Hunter classes require proof of pedigree; TIP membership is acceptable.

Horses and ponies may enter no more than seven "over fences" classes, no more than five of which can be Jumper classes, on a single show day. All warm-up trips and special classes, such as equitation medals, hunter classics, derbies, and stakes classes are included in this total. All Jumper classics, stakes, warm-ups, and clear round classes shall count towards the limit of five Jumper classes.

Equitation Classes

Short Stirrup Equitation Open to qualified Short Stirrup rider. Fence height 2'.

<u>Long Stirrup Equitation</u> Open to qualified Long Stirrup riders. Fence height 2'3".

Equitation 11 & Under Open to Juniors whose 12th birthday is not before December 1, 2022. Fence height 2'. No straight lines may be set at less than 60'.

Equitation 12-14 Open to Juniors whose 15th birthday is not before December 1, 2022. Fence height 2'6". No straight lines may be set at less than 60'.

Equitation 15-17 Open to Juniors whose 18th birthday is not before December 1, 2022. Fence height 3'

Adult Equitation Open to Adult Amateurs. Fence height 3'

Jumper Classes

.80 m (2'7") Jumper Open to all riders on horses or ponies.
Low Child/Adult Jumper .85 m (2'9") Open to Junior and
Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Horse/rider combo
may not cross enter into classes higher than .90m at the
same horse show

.90 m (2'll") Jumper Open to all riders on horses or ponies.

Child/Adult Jumper .95 m (3'1") Open to Junior and Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Horse/rider combo may not cross enter into classes higher than 1.10m (3'7") at the same horse show

1.00 m (3'3") Jumper Open to all riders on horses or ponies.

<u>**1.10 m (3'7") Jumper**</u> Open to all riders on horses or ponies.

Medal Classes

Specifications for GHJA Medals Must be a GHJA Member to compete in the GHJA Medal classes. To be shown over a modified jumper-type course of at least 8 fences. The course must include at least one oxer and one change of direction. To be judged on seat, hands, guidance, and control of the horse. A minimum of 6 riders, if available, will be required to show on the flat. The flat phase shall count for 25%. Judges may require riders to perform any USEF test 1-23. Management has the option of placing two tests from USEF 1-8 into the jumping phase in lieu of the 25% flat phase. Three entries must complete the over fences and testing requirements for qualification points to count.

GHJA Pony Medal

Ponies with measurement cards to be ridden by Junior riders. Small ponies to be ridden by Junior riders 12 years of age or under to be jumped at 2'. Medium ponies to be ridden by Junior riders 14 years of age or under to be jumped at 2'3". Large ponies to be ridden by Juniors to be jumped at 2'6".

J.D. Pounds Junior Medal

Open to Juniors on horses. Fence height 3'.

GHJA Adult Medal

Open to Adult Amateurs on horses or ponies. Fence height 3'. Ponies may not be shown by a junior in any other classes

GHJA Medals can be combined if there are less than three in any of the three medals. However, rider/horse must jump at appropriate fence height.

GHJA Equitation Challenge

Walk, trot, and canter. Competitors will be asked to perform at least two of the following USEF tests chosen by the Judge: #2- Halt (4 to 6 seconds) or Halt and Back; #10- Change leads on a line demonstrating a simple or flying change of lead; #13- Ride without stirrups; #15- Canter on the counter lead (Note: no more than twelve horses may counter canter at one time); #19- Perform basic dressage movements. Judges may choose from shoulder in, shoulder out, haunches in, haunches out, leg yield, and half pass; #20- Hand gallop. Martingales are not permitted. Riders receiving outside assistance or coaching while in the arena will be eliminated. Riders who have won the final GHJA Equitation Challenge in the previous three years are no longer eligible to compete in this class. November 1st is the cut-off date for riding in qualifying classes at shows.

See GHJA rule book Appendix B for tests' details.

Hunter Classes

<u>Silver Stirrup Hunter</u>: Open to adult amateur riders, 35 years of age and older, who have not shown in classes with fence heights 2'6" or higher in the past three (3) years. **Fence height 2'**, no oxers.

Pre-Children's Hunter: Open to Junior riders on horses or ponies; horse/rider com-bination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show in the previous 3 years. Fence height 2'6". Horse rider combo MAY NOT cross enter into children's hunter.

Pre-Adult Hunter: Open to Adult Amateur riders on horse or ponies; horse/rider combination may not have competed at 3'3" or higher at any Local or Regular Member horse show in the previous 3 years. Fence height 2'6". Horse Rider Combo MAY NOT cross enter into Adult

<u>Children's Hunter:</u> Open to all horses ridden by a Junior. Fence height 3'. Horse/rider combo MAY NOT cross enter into Pre Children's Hunter.

Adult Amateur Hunter: Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. A pony ridden in the Adult Amateur Hunters may not cross enter into any Pony Hunter division or Junior Equitation classes or Junior Medal at the same show. Fence height 3'. Horse/rider combo MAY NOT cross enter into Pre-Adult Hunter.

Thoroughbred Hunter: Open to any registered Thoroughbred, ridden by juniors, amateurs, or professional riders.

Fence height 2'6 or 2'9 at the discretion of show management. Non-registered thoroughbred horses may apply for approved eligibility by submitting reliable proof of pedigree to GHJA.

Green Hunter: 2'3" or 2'6" at the discretion of show management. Open to horses and ponies in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 2' at any show. A horse or pony's eligibility is limited to two consecutive show years during which time the horse or pony may not show in any division with fences higher than 2'6" or it will lose its Green status. Open to all riders. A pony ridden by an adult or professional rider may not cross enter into any Pony Hunter, Junior Equitation, or Junior Medal class at the same show.

<u>Modified Hunter:</u> Open to all horses or ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs or professionals. Fence height 2'9". <u>Open Hunter:</u> Open to all horses or ponies ridden by juniors, amateurs or professionals. Fence height 2'6" or 3'. Rider may show at either height group at rider's or trainer's discretion.

<u>Performance Hunter</u>: Open to all riders on horses. Fence height 3'3"/3'6".

<u>Schooling Pony</u>: Open to Junior riders only on ponies. Fence height 2' or 2'6". May jump either height at the rider's or trainer's discretion.

<u>Small Pony Hunter</u>: Open to Junior riders 12 years of age or under on ponies not to exceed 12.2 hh. Fence height 2'. <u>Medium Pony Hunter</u>: Open to Junior riders 14 years of age or under on ponies over 12.2 hh, but not to exceed 13.2 hh. Fence height 2'3".

<u>Large Pony Hunter</u>: Open to Junior riders on ponies not to exceed 14.2 hh. Fence height 2'6".

Hunter Classes

Short Stirrup Hunter: Short Stirrup Hunter: Open to riders ages 12 years and under, on horses or ponies, in their first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any horse show. Fence height 2'. Riders may show in Short Stirrup classes for two consecutive years, as defined by the show calendar year starting December 1st and ending November 30th. The two years of eligibility may not be separated or divided in any manner. Short and Long Stirrup eligibility are counted together when age eligibility overlaps during the two years: a rider may compete in Short and/or Long Stirrup Divisions for a total of two consecutive show years. Eligibility is determined by the rider, without regard to horse-rider combination.

The rider must adhere to the following parameters at all GHJA locally sanctioned and USEF recognized shows:

- (i) Short Stirrup eligible riders may enter or cross-enter into only hunter classes or divisions that are unrecognized by GHJA or USEF. Fence height not to exceed 2'3";
- (ii) Short Stirrup eligible riders may enter or cross-enter into age group equitation divisions that do not to exceed 2'6" in height;
- (iii) Short Stirrup eligible riders **may not** enter or cross-enter into GHJA or USEF recognized Medal classes;
- (iv) Short Stirrup eligible riders may only enter or cross-enter in Jumper classes at or below 0.65m. See current GHJA Rule Book for further clarification regarding eligibility (this is a brief version)

Long Stirrup Hunter: Long Stirrup Hunter: Open to Junior and Amateur riders ages 13 years and older on horses or ponies, in the rider's first or second year of showing over fences higher than 18" in any horse show. Fence height 2'3". Riders may show in Long Stirrup for two consecutive show years, as defined by the show calendar year starting December 1st and ending November 30th. The two years of eligibility may not be separated or divided in any manner. Short and Long Stirrup eligibility are counted together when age eligibility overlaps during the two years: a rider may compete in Short and/or Long Stirrup for a total of two consecutive years. Eligibility is determined by the rider, without regard to horse-rider combination.

The rider must adhere to the following parameters at all GHJA locally sanctioned and USEF recognized shows:

- (i) Long Stirrup eligible riders **may** enter or cross-enter into only hunter classes or divisions that are unrecognized by GHJA or USEF. Fence height not to exceed 2'6";
- (ii) Long Stirrup eligible riders **may** enter or cross-enter into age group equitation divisions that do not to exceed 2'6" in height;
- (iii) Long Stirrup eligible riders **may not** enter or cross-enter into GHJA or USEF recognized Medal classes;
- (iv) Long Stirrup eligible riders **may** only enter or cross-enter in Jumper classes at or below 0.70 m.

Entries and stall reservations will be accepted by email or online at www.horseshowsonline.com Management is not responsible for entry errors due to incomplete or illegible entry forms. Entries received after close will be charged a late fee.

Entry forms must be **complete** and **signed**.

Numbers Issued only with a signed open check deposited with the horse show secretary. Classes offered will be conducted and judged according to the appropriate sanctioning organizations rules. Social Security Numbers | Federal ID Numbers Owner's Social Security number or Federal ID number MUST be on the entry form of any horse and/or pony exhibited in classes where prize money is awarded

Competition Office Hours Competition Days one hour before start of first class 30 min. following completion of last class.

Membership Numbers A signed entry blank with association membership numbers for each horse, owner, rider, and trainer must be submitted to the show office prior to end of show for points to count. Service Fees All entries, (horse | rider entry) will be charged an office fee and schooling fee. All stabled horses will be charged a Night watch fee.

Fee Splits The show office will split tack stalls and shavings counts per Trainer instructions up to close of office on Friday. At that time office will evenly assign fee splits.

Stabling Bedding A minimum of two bags shavings per stall is mandatory. Bedding orders are to be made through the office. No outside deliveries.

Damage All owners and exhibitors shall be held responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents, or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds and be billed accordingly.

Refunds will not be made after the show begins except for lameness of horse or illness of rider. Refunds due to billing errors will be made only within 24 hours after close of show. Please check your bills carefully.

Lunging No lunging permitted in the show rings or schooling areas at any time. Lunging only in designated areas.

Poling & Offsets Manual poling and the use of bamboo offsets are prohibited for all horses competing. Anyone involved in poling will be subject to a fine of \$500.

Schooling in the show rings without permission is prohibited at all times. Warm up will be available on Friday as designated and before the show each day. Closing times will be announced each day and schooling will be restricted as conditions warrant.

Non Stabling Horses Horses entered but not stabled must use the designated areas for day exhibitors. Grounds fees and other administrative fees apply.

Non Showing Horse All non-showing horses must have a signed entry blank in the show office and pay non-showing and applicable administrative fees.

Non Negotiable Payments Returned checks will be charged a Non-Sufficient Funds fee of \$35; Credit Cards that are rejected will be charged a NPF of \$35. Accounts will have three days to make full payment with penalties by cashiers check. Overnight mail is advised to avoid notification of sanctioning organizations of failure to make payment.

Concessions will be available show days.

Parking Fire regulations prohibit all vehicles, including trailers, vans, and campers from being parked in the stabling areas. Vehicles will be allowed in stable areas for loading purposes only. Parking areas are designated and violators will be towed or ticketed at owner's expense.

Protective Headgear All exhibitors are required to wear properly fitting ASTM protective headgear on the show grounds when mounted with harness secured snugly and properly fitted while riding in designated schooling and exercise areas, the show ring, and while jumping anywhere on the grounds. It is the responsibility of the rider, parents, guardian, or trainer of the junior exhibitor to see that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards and is properly fitted and in good condition.

Minor Riders Parent(s) or guardian(s) of a minor child shall hold the horse show management and the facility harmless for any injury to such minor. No minor child's entry will be accepted or number issued unless a parent or LEGAL guardian signs entry.

Dogs All dogs must be on a leash or otherwise securely contained at all times while on the show grounds. Said leash must be no more than 6 feet in length and must be held in hand or secured to an immobile fixture. Retractable leashes must be locked at a length of 6 feet or less. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dog's behaviors. Loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to impoundment by the horse show or by local authorities. Owners of loose and/or disruptive dogs may be subject to penalties and/or fines under GHJA rules 18 & 19. Warning cards may be issued to dog owners, an accumulation of which shall result in further penalties.

Conduct Any act of Discourtesy to a Judge or Show Official or Staff Member on the part of trainer, owner, rider, or groom or parent or guardian will immediately disqualify any horse with which they are associated and all entry fees will be forfeited.

Schooling Fee Schooling fee is applied to each entry for all riders.

Motorized Vehicles Unlicensed drivers are not permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including but not limited to golf carts, scooters, and mopeds.

Membership No points will be counted toward GHJA annual awards before membership dues have been paid and the horse or pony is registered with GHJA

Measurement Ponies must possess a current GHJA or USEF measurement card, to be presented at check in

Course Strides Courses are set on a 12' stride.

Over Fences Limit Ponies/Horses may not enter more than seven over fences classes in any one show day, no more than 5 of which may be jumper classes. Limits include equitation medals, Hunter Classics and warm up classes.

Show Ring Conflicts Three Minute Policy will be in effect at management's discretion. Upon notification to exhibitors the classes can be canceled, if there is not a horse in the ring within three minutes of the start of the time clock. No refunds will be issued. Please be considerate to your fellow exhibitors.

Judging All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Management may restrict the courtesy circle by mandatory dotted line which shall be indicated on the course diagram. If order of go is established, the one minute policy will be in effect. Otherwise the three minute policy will be in effect.

Attire Proper attire is required in all classes except warm up classes, when chaps or other non-standard attire may be worn. Management or judge may eliminate an exhibitor who is inappropriately attired. This rule does not supersede rules that prescribe attire for beginner riders or variations in outerwear prescribed by show managers/judges during extremely hot, cold or inclement weather.

Jumper Classes To be eligible for prize money awards you must enter respective division during the

Holding Classes Under no circumstances will a flat class or under saddle be held for a trainer conflict, unless the conflict concerns the horse being in another ring. Equitation classes and jumper classes, may at management's discretion, follow a posted order of go. Management may designate priority rings.

Electrical / Fire Regulations All electrical installation and connections must meet all state and county codes. Aisle shall be maintained clear for a minimum of six feet wide by eight feet high. No obstructions or projections shall be allowed in the aisles. No Class I Flammable liquids such as gasoline are allowed inside the buildings. Cooking is not permitted within any stabling area. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to dismissal from further participation in the horse show without recourse.

Liability Horse Show Ventures, the facility operators, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitors, spectators, guest, groom, attendant, other employees, animals, or equipment at any of the competitions. All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third persons caused by themselves, their employees, agents, horses or dogs. They are strongly advised to take out third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events, and to keep that policy up to date. The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. AllI questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show management. Its decision shall be final. Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but show management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the horse show and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of the horse show and the facilities at which the horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his/her horse(s), employees(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire, or other cause. Show Management reserves the right to limit entries in any class, section, or division, to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes without any claim for damages; to

change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to exhibitors, to change rings or rotate judges, to change specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

Entries All Entry Forms must be signed by an adult: competitor, parent, and/or Trainer as designated. Email, address, and contact cell phone number must be included.

Prizes & Awards Ribbons will be awarded first through sixth place. Championship and Reserve Champion ribbons and awards (as applicable) will be awarded for hunter divisions with at least two over fences and an under saddle class with three competitors completing classes. Prize Monies will be deducted from show bills with check for any balance issued no later than 30 days from show date. Federal ID number must be provided for receipt of prize money. Classes offering prize money must have designated number of entries to award full cash amount. If less than the minimum the entry, fee will be reduced and the class will become an addback. The added money will be distributed among top placings (30%, 25%, 20%, 10%, 10%, 5%). If class has a minimum of 3 but less than five the entry fee will be reduced and no cash will be awarded. Normal ribbons and prizes will then apply.

Champion & Reserve for 25+ divisions each show day. 10 points first place, 6 points second place, 4 points third place, 2 points fourth place, 1 point fifth place, .5 point for sixth place. Champion 20 points, Reserve Champion 12 points.

In case of a tie for Champion or Reserve, award goes to rider with most points over fences. Champion and Reserve receive special ribbons and awards.

Points & Year End Awards To be eligible for HSV year end awards, the rider, owner, and horse/pony must be a member of Horse Show Ventures. Point accumulation begins on the date that completed registration and payment is received.

USHJA OUTREACH

Outreach Membership is free. All Outreach class participants must join as a USHJA Outreach member to be eligible for awards. Horses are **not required** to be registered with USHJA or be microchipped to compete in Outreach classes.

Hunter Sections

All courses must have at least seven jumps and no combinations are allowed. Oxers are discouraged for any class with fences below 2'6". At one day USHJA Outreach Shows, only the first two numbered over fences classes (hunters), regardless of how many classes are held, and one hunter under saddle class in each hunter section will count for USHJA Outreach points. At multiple day USHJA Outreach Shows, only the first three numbered over fences classes, regardless of how many classes are held, and one under saddle class in each hunter section will count for USHJA Outreach points.

- a. USHJA Outreach Hunters Walk/Trot Riders may not compete in any over fences classes at the same show. Riders to show at a walk and trot both ways of the ring.
- b. USHJA Outreach Hunters 18" or Cross rail Riders must be juniors or amateurs, and may not compete in any class where the fences exceed 2'0" at the same show.
- c. USHJA Outreach Hunters 2'0"- Riders may not compete in any class where the fences exceed 2'3" at the same show.
- d. USHJA Outreach Hunters 2'3"- Riders may not compete in any class where fences exceed 2'6" at the same show.
- e. USHJA Outreach Hunters 2'6"- Riders may not compete in any class where the fences exceed 2'9" at the same show.
- f. USHJA Outreach Hunters 2'9" Riders may not compete in any class where the fences exceed 3'0" at the same show
- g. USHJA Outreach Hunters 3'0"- Riders may not compete in any class where the fences exceed 3'3" at the same show.
- *May only be offered at Category 1 Outreach competitions.
- h. USHJA Outreach Hunter Derby is held over a single-round course of at least 10 fences at 2'6" in height, with three option fences set at 2'9". The course will consist of hunter classic and hunter handy style lines, turns and jumps. The judge will use the open numerical scoring system. After the judge's score is given, one point will be added for each high option fence jumped successfully (no knockdowns or refusals) for a maximum of three additional points added to the judge's score. Only one Derby may be held during a given show.

C. Jumper Sections

- 1. All courses must have at least seven jumps and no combinations are allowed. Oxers are discouraged for any class with fences below .75m. At one day USHJA Outreach Shows, only the first three numbered jumper classes in each section will count for USHJA Outreach points. At multiple day USHJA Outreach Shows, up to four Jumper classes in a section will count for points, with no more than two classes per day counting for points. Show organizers are encouraged to use USEF Jumper Table IV, Sections 1 or 2 (Optimum Time) for scoring USHJA Outreach Jumper classes. The only other tables allowed are Table II, Section 2, a,b,c, or d, and Table II, Section 1. No other USEF Jumper scoring tables are allowed.
- a. USHJA Outreach Jumpers .70m Riders may not compete in any class where the fences exceed .80m at the same show.
- b. USHJA Outreach Jumpers .75-.80m Riders may not compete in any class where the fences exceed .85m at the same show.
- c. USHJA Outreach Jumpers .85m- Riders may not compete in any class where the fences exceed .95m at the same show.
- d. USHJA Outreach Jumpers .90-.95m Riders may not compete in any class where the fences exceed 1.0m at the same show.











B. Equitation Sections

- 1. All courses must have at least seven jumps and no combinations are allowed. Oxers are discouraged for any class with fences below 2'6". At one day USHJA Outreach Shows, only the first two numbered over fences classes. regardless of how many classes are held, and one equitation flat class in each equitation section will count for USHJA Outreach points. At multiple day USHJA Outreach Shows, only the first three numbered over fences classes, regardless of how many classes are held, and one flat class in each equitation section will count for USHJA Outreach points. Riders must be juniors or amateurs.
 - a. USHJA Outreach Equitation Walk/Trot Riders may not compete in any over fences class at the same show. Riders to show at a walk and trot both ways of the ring.
 - b. USHJA Outreach W-T-C Equitation Riders may not compete in any over fences at the same show. Riders to show at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring.
 - c. USHJA Outreach Equitation 18" or Crossrails Riders may not compete in any class where the fences exceed 2'0" at the same show.
 - d. USHJA Outreach Equitation 2'0" Riders may not compete in any class where the fences exceed 2'3" at the same show.
 - e. USHJA Outreach Equitation 2'3" Riders may not compete in any class where fences exceed 2'6" at the same show.
 - f. USHJA Outreach Equitation 2'6" Riders may not compete in any class where fences exceed 2'9" at the same show.
 - g. USHJA Outreach Equitation 2'9" Riders may not compete in any class where the fences exceed 3'0" at the same show
 - h. USHJA Outreach Equitation 3'0" Riders may not compete in any class where the fences exceed 3'3" at the same show.
 - *May only be offered at Category 1 Outreach competitions

IV. Points

A. At least three entries must complete the course or class for points to count. B. Points will accrue through sixth place for any class that has six or more entries. In classes with six or more entries, full points will accrue as follows: 10-6-4-2-

> 1-.05. 5 entries: 6-4-2-1-0.5 4 entries: 4-2-1-0.5

3 entries: 2-1-0.5

- C. A rider's home zone will be determined by their place of residence during the current competition year. If a rider changes zones, because of school, work, or otherwise, he must request permission change his home zone to the USHJA in writing in order for his points to follow him. Points will follow the USHJA competition year, December 1 to November 30.
- D. USHJA will provide certificates of merit in three categories in each USHJA Outreach section or class.
- 1. Bronze Level: riders must earn at least 30 points during the competition year.
- 2. Silver Level: riders must earn at least 50 points during the competition vear.
- 3. Gold Level: riders must earn at least 75 points during the competition year.
- 4. Certificates will be awarded by zone, and if a zone banquet is held the zone committee is strongly encouraged to present USHJA Outreach certificates during the banquet. Otherwise certificates will be mailed. When a rider achieves Bronze the USHJA will mail the certificate at that time. Presentations of Silver and Gold certificates will be awarded at the end of the year.)
